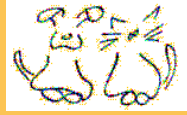

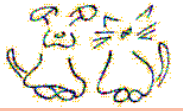

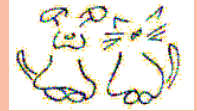


VOLUNTEER Wanted – Event Planner & Coordinator

HELP SAVE FERAL CATS

The Blue Moon Feral Sanctuary at the Flagler Humane Society was created to help save the lives of a limited number of feral cats. These ferals were formally in colonies that were in unsafe public situations or were in danger of losing their habitat. Each cat has been spayed or neutered, vaccinated and an ear clipped.



The outdoor facility is situated on a half-acre refuge sheltered by tall trees and native bushes. The sanctuary provides a natural, free-roaming fenced in environment for the cats.

There are over one hundred shelters for the cats to sleep in, numerous covered feeding stations and fresh food and water is provided daily.

There is no paid staff and our only source of funding is from public donations and volunteer contributions. 100% of your donation goes directly to the animals.

So, what happened to..... and how is s/he doing?

BUCK AND HUCK

Do you remember Buck and Huck? Two hounds who came to the Shelter the end of January? Well, unfortunately, Buck is still with us but Huck? He's doing pretty good. He was adopted on 20 April.

Almost three months after Huck came to the Shelter, a woman (whose sir name partially included "Huck") visited the Shelter. When she saw Huck, a hound with a scared nose which looked like the hair had been ripped out by its roots) said to herself, "I can't believe it! This is meant to be!" And so, Huck went home.

About three weeks later, a volunteer called the woman to see how Huck was doing. The answer: Huck is doing very well. He has two new playmates. One is an eight-year old dog whom Huck plays with a lot but when the older boy says "enough", the older dog chases Huck until he backs off. Huck also lives with a cat whom Huck also chases but one day the cat also will say "enough".

Now, how is Huck, himself doing? He's coming along great with potty training. He's as sweet as he can be. Huck is still chewing things but the woman said she admits it's her fault because she leaves things laying around for him to get." She is "very happy with Huck; he's a sweet boy; we just love him and are very happy with him. And, where does Huck sleep? Well, wherever he wants to, on every bed and couch!

UPDATE!!

Just got a phone call from the shelter with the news that my friend "Buck", a hound at the shelter since January, has finally found a home (pray it sticks). He came to us with "Huck" about a month ago. I don't know why they were overlooked for so long, but both are young dogs (maybe just over a year) so now they have got a lifetime to enjoy the good life

BRISTOL AND NASCAR

The owner of Nascar, a four-year old male Shepherd mix and Bristol, a 1-1/2 year old Labrador retriever mix, reluctantly surrendered them when they lost their home. The owner begged the Shelter to try to find homes for them together since they were never apart. While at the Shelter, they remained kenneled together for three months until a man adopted Bristol leaving Nascar alone. However, Bristol's adoption didn't last long – only one week. The man returned her stating that he couldn't handle her because she was too active. Shortly after returning, Bristol was adopted again by a family with a child. Again, Bristol was returned. This time the reason was that Bristol showed "no" interest in the six-month old child. When Bristol returned this time, she found that Nascar was no longer waiting for her. The day before she returned, Nascar found a home without her. The "inseparable duo" would never see each other again. That's the sad part of this story.

On the brighter side: Nascar has not returned to the Shelter and Bristol only stayed at the Shelter for about three weeks before being adopted for the third time. A woman saw Bristol's picture on Petfinder and fell in love with her immediately. The family already had Luke, an active dog who needed a friend. From the first time Luke met Bristol at the Shelter, he adored her. The woman said that Luke never had a companion and when he met Bristol his tail started wagging and has never stopped.

At first, Bristol was very shy and carried her tail between her legs. The woman could see she was heartbroken. Maybe she missed Nascar. Slowly, Bristol adjusted to her new home and her new family.

Bristol's new mom's ending remarks were: "I can't say enough good things about Bristol. She's so loving and smart; we just love her. My only wish is that I could have found her sooner."

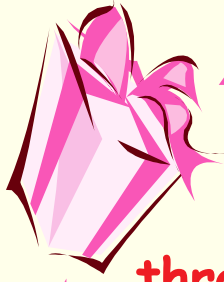

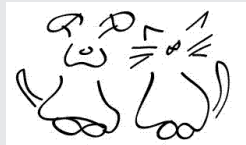
