

LOW-COST SPAY/NEUTER

With cooperation from our volunteer veterinarians and our local veterinarians, pet owners who cannot otherwise afford to have an animal sterilized may purchase a low-cost certificate from the shelter. Vaccines, flea prevention, and some miscellaneous services may also be purchased at a reduced rate with the surgery.

Flagler County offers an incentive to encourage pet sterilization in the form of a \$25.00 rebate. Forms for this may be filled out at the shelter.

VOLUNTEERS

LICENSES

The shelter sells licenses for dogs and cats in Palm Coast. Proof of current rabies vaccination is required. Cost is \$5.00 for sterilized pets, \$10.00 intact.

FUNDING

Flagler Humane Society, Inc. is a non-profit organization which is financed by memberships, donations, and fees for services. Contracts with Flagler County, Flagler Beach, Palm Coast, and Bunnell finance some costs associated with providing animal control.

Donations to the Flagler Humane Society are tax deductible. Donors' names and addresses are not shared with other organizations or businesses.

Funds are spent carefully with the best interest of the animals in mind.

A little history...

The Flagler Humane Society has been in operation since 1982 and was originally staffed entirely by volunteers. Today it still relies heavily on volunteers to provide services to the unwanted, abused, and homeless animals of the area.

The shelter receives approximately 4,000 animals per year. As Flagler County grows, so does the need for animal services. Flagler Humane Society is the only animal shelter in Flagler County.

Over 85% of the animals brought to our shelter are saved. Please keep your pet's identification up to date so that your pet can be returned to you if it is lost.

SHELTER AND CARE

We provide a 24 hour receiving center for any stray, surrendered, or abandoned animal. However, it is preferred that animals be brought in during regular business hours.

ADOPTION

Wonderful pets may be obtained through the Flagler Humane Society. Adopters must go through a screening process. Animals are health checked, vaccinated, wormed, and spayed or neutered.

CRUELTY INVESTIGATIONS

Reports of animal cruelty are investigated by a trained investigator. All abuse reports are investigated and complainants may remain anonymous.

LOST AND FOUND

Information on missing or found animals is kept at the shelter. If you have lost or found an animal, you should contact the shelter.

WILDLIFE

Stranded, orphaned and injured wildlife are referred to a licensed rehabilitator. Nuisance wildlife will be referred to a licensed trapper.

ANIMAL SERVICES

Animal Services Officers provide animal control within Flagler County, except Palm Coast. Officers can be reached at 386-445-1188 or after business hours by contacting Flagler County Sheriff's Dispatch.

EDUCATION

Speakers and Humane Education programs are provided to schools and civic groups. Tours of the shelter are also available. Students writing reports or speeches can request information. Printed

EUTHANASIA

Owners wishing to have an old or terminally ill pet put to sleep may schedule an appointment. Owners are allowed, if they so desire, to be with their pet as it is given a painless injection. A \$40.00 donation is requested for this service.

WELLNESS CLINIC

Low-cost basic healthcare. Ten days a month. Call us for an appointment.
