Guidelines for Program

1. Submit a fully complete request.
2. Must be 18 years old age.
3. Provide proof of identity.
4. Dog food will given out according to the following scale:

Small pets (under 40 lbs) will receive up to a 20 lb bag of food
Med/Lg Pets (over 40 lbs) will receive up to a 50 lb bag of food

(The Flagler Humane Society has the right to determine the amount of dog food given per person. The above scale is just a guide and can be amended at any time.)

5. Limited to 4 requests in a one-year period.
6. Provide Rabies Vaccination Certificates for each pet. If not current on vaccinations, make an appointment with the Flagler Humane Society Wellness Clinic to update. You may still receive the food at this time, but will not receive any additional assistance until proof of a current vaccine is provided.
