FOSTER HOME PROGRAM

REASONS FOR FOSTER HOMES

Far too often animals come into the shelter that need that little “something extra” in order for them to be adopted. With 4,500 animals a year, the staff is unable to offer this extra treatment. That is where foster homes come into play.

Animals can need foster homes for any number of reasons, such as too young, no mothers, injured, sick or behavior issues.

If you are able to meet the fostering requirements and are willing to help these abandoned or abused animals find a loving forever home, then this is your opportunity.

FOSTERING REQUIREMENTS

- ◆ Flagler County resident, 21 years of age.
- ◆ All owned animals must be current on vaccinations and able to accept new animals in their home.
- ◆ Ability to keep animals separate in your home as they may be harboring disease.
- ◆ Fenced yard (negotiable).
- ◆ Ability to bring foster animal into shelter for veterinary checks as needed.
- ◆ Complete Volunteer Application.
- ◆ Attend Volunteer Orientation.
- ◆ Aggressively work toward finding the foster animal a home.

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FOSTER HOME AGREEMENT

I have met all requirements of the foster program and agree to provide temporary care for animals in my home.

I understand that I am financially responsible for the animal's essential needs such as food (Science Diet), water, shelter, and exercise while in my custody.

I understand that these animals are not owned by me and must be returned upon demand to the Flagler Humane Society. I will immediately notify the shelter of any health problems or needs of the animal so that they may direct me.

Within 90 days of this agreement, I must adopt the animal or return it to the shelter. I understand and agree to the adoption process and all fees that apply if I decide to adopt this fostered animal.
