Low Cost Spay/Neuter Program

About the Program

Every year, countless dogs and cats end up homeless due to the pet overpopulation crises in our community. To provide an affordable opportunity for spaying and neutering, our shelter issues a limited number of low cost certificates each month for sale to income qualified Flagler County residents. Please purchase a certificate at the shelter and we will schedule your pet's surgery date.

Requirements

Your dog or cat should be healthy and at least 4 months of age. Pets in heat will not be spayed. FeLV/FIV positive cats will not be spayed / neutered. Heartworm positive dog cases will be based on our vet's discretion. Owner must provide proof of current routine vaccinations. Owner must provide: proof of financial hardship; proof of negative heartworm test (dogs 6+ months) or negative FeLV/FIV test (cats). Otherwise, these service fees can either be included in the initial certificate cost or collected before surgery drop-off time, and services performed on the surgery date. Only rabies vaccine vet record (not tag) will be accepted as proof of rabies vaccination.

Fees

Surgery fees listed here are discounted an additional \$25 for Flagler County residents. The term "neuter" refers to a male, and "spay" to a female. Accepted forms of payment are cash or credit card.

Surgery

- Cat Neuter \$40
- Cat Spay \$65
- Dog Neuter \$75
- Dog Spay under 40 lbs. \$100
- Dog Spay over \$40 lbs. \$135

Preventive Care - Dogs

- DHPP vaccine - \$15
- Rabies vaccine - \$15
- Heartworm Test \$25
- Canine Flu vaccine (optional) \$15

Preventive Care - Cats

- FVR-CP vaccine - \$15
- Rabies vaccine \$15
- FeLV/FIV Test \$25
- FeLV vaccine (optional)

Scheduling

Certificates are valid 30 days from date of purchase. Drop off time is 8:00-8:30 am and pick up is 4:30-5:00 pm the same day. The majority of certificate surgeries are performed by our staff vet at the shelter. However, there are a few local veterinarians who will honor the certificates based on their own terms.

Post Op Care

Our technicians will provide you with an information handout at the time of pickup. Please follow all instructions carefully for the recommended durations. Depending on the type of surgery, some patients will receive an injection of pain medication following the procedure. In these cases, our technicians may also dispense additional pain medication for you to administer at home.
